**Absolutely NO CARS will be permitted at camp sites.** All cars dropping off items at campers must be out by 9:00 a.m. on Monday, or they will be towed. There will be no camper/exhibitor parking to the east of the horse practice arena or across the lane to the east of that area starting Thursday at 9 am. The fair has events that will utilize those areas. Towing will be at the owner's expense.

Golf Cart permits may be applied for. Applications are available in the FairBoard office. A handicap permit, driver's license, and proof of liability insurance must be brought to the office and turned in with the application. A permit will be given to those approved. The FairBoard will have utility carts available to help with moving feed and supplies from 7:00 to 8:00 am & 5-6 pm. Please see FairBoard members for assistance. Any unauthorized vehicles must be removed promptly.

Every person camping on the fairgrounds during the fair week will be required to read and sign the code of conduct form. This form is available online or in the office and must accompany the camping registration form.

Campers shall be solely responsible for any injuries to people or damage to property or any other injury, claim, damage, or loss of whatever nature arising directly or indirectly from the event. Contractor shall INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS Sanilac County 4-H Agricultural Society and Fairboard and its

employees, agents, and volunteers from and against all liability, loss, damages, claims, costs and expenses (including attorney fees) arising out of injury to person or damages to property or any other injury, claim, damage, loss, cost or expense arising from the event.
